



## COVID-19 Update – Court Closures

<b>Nationwide</b>	Please expect delays in many jurisdictions across the country, particularly in areas where clerks need to be involved to verify ID's, get case details not on terminals, file orders, etc. All courts are short staffed, not only due to illness, but also because schools are cancelled and most states are on lockdown or restricted access.
<b>Tribal Courts</b>	Please expect delays in all jurisdictions as most court clerks need to be involved hands-on searches.
<b>AK, AL, AR, AZ</b>	For now, searches in these states are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays, unless clerks need to get involved for file copies, etc.
<b>CA</b>	<p>In the following counties, service has been fully restored. Please expect delays as the backlog is being worked through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Alameda, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Colusa, Contra Costa, Del Norte, El Dorado, Fresno, Glenn, Imperial, Kern, Kings, Lake, Lassen, Los Angeles, Mariposa, Mendocino, Merced, Monterey, Napa, Orange, Placer, Riverside, Sacramento, San Benito, San Bernardino, San Diego, San Francisco, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, Santa Cruz, Sierra, Siskiyou, Sonoma, Stanislaus, Sutter, Tehama, Trinity, Tulare, Ventura, Yolo, Yuba</li></ul> <p>In the following counties the clerk counters are closed to the public. Searches can still be done. <b>CO</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>CT</b>	In the following counties the clerk counters are closed to the public. Searches can still be done. However, files cannot be ordered and searches requiring clerk assistance can not be completed until further notice. Clears and most completed cases can be done. Pending cases and some completed cases require clerk assistance. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All Counties</li> </ul>
<b>DC</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>DE</b>	We again have public access in all DE counties, as well as DE Statewide searches. Please expect delays as the backlogs are worked through.
<b>FL</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>GA</b>	We again have public access in all GA counties, including Greene, with the exceptions noted below. Please expect delays as the backlogs are worked through. <p>Public access is available in these GA counties. However, files and searches requiring assistance may be delayed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bryan, Clayton, Cobb, Fayette, Gwinnett, Lee, Newton, Richmond</li> </ul> <p>Public access is available in these GA counties. However, our researchers have very limited access. Please expect delays:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Treutlen, Whitfield</li> </ul> <p>*Until things are back to normal, it may be a good idea to run Statewide GA searches instead of county level searches in for the above listed counties. *Note - a signed release will be necessary.</p>

<b>HI, IA, ID, IL, IN</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>KS</b>	Searches in all KS counties including Clay, Dickinson, Geary, Marion, Morris are now able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>KY</b>	We again have limited access in all KY counties. Please expect delays as the backlog is worked through.  *Until things are back to normal, it may be a good idea to run Statewide KY searches instead of county level searches in Kentucky. *Note - there is a \$25 state fee for KY Statewide searches, in addition to our fee.
<b>LA</b>	We again have regular access in all counties including Vermilion. Please expect delays as the backlog is worked through.
<b>MA</b>	Service has been restored in all MA Counties on a very limited basis. Expect delays.
<b>MD</b>	Most searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays. However, files cannot be ordered and searches requiring clerk assistance can not be completed until further notice.
<b>ME</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>MI</b>	We again have full access to all counties that are not listed below. Please expect delays as the backlog is worked through.  In the following counties the clerk counters are closed to the public. Searches can still be done. However, files cannot be ordered and searches requiring clerk assistance can not be completed until further notice: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Allegan, Antrim, Barry, Berrien, Cheboygan, Grand Traverse, Isabella, Jackson, Leelanau, Macomb, Monroe, Montmorency, Muskegon, Van Buren</li></ul>

	<p>These MI courts have seen a great reduction in court staff, causing delays, until further notice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Alcona, Benzie, Dickinson, Keweenaw, Lake, Mecosta, Montcalm, Ontonagon, Osceola, Oscoda, Sanilac</li> </ul> <p>For the following Counties, terminals are inaccessible to the public, and there are no searches being done by clerks until further notice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bay, Gladwin, SaintJoseph</li> </ul> <p>Until things are back to normal, for the above listed counties, it may be a good idea to run Statewide MI searches instead of county level searches. The Statewide MI search through the MI State Police isn't the greatest in terms of coverage and reporting, but it is something. *Note - there is a \$10 state fee for MI Statewide searches, in addition to our fee.</p>
<b>MN, MO</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>MS, MT</b>	Service has been restored in all MS counties. Please expect delays as the backlog is being worked through.
<b>NC, ND, NE, NH</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>NJ</b>	Very limited service has been restored in all NJ counties. Please expect delays as the enormous backlog is being worked through.
<b>NM, NV</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>NY</b>	<p>Full, regular service has been restored in all counties except Albany. Please expect delays as the backlogs are worked through.</p> <p>For the following Counties, terminals are inaccessible to the public, and there are no searches being done by clerks until further notice:</p>

<b>OH, OK, OR, PA</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>RI, SC, SD</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>TN</b>	<p>Service has been restored in all TN counties except Lake. Please understand that there may be delays as the backlog is being worked through.</p> <p><b>Lake County TN has been shut down again for at least two weeks, because of Covid-19 spread within the court.</b></p>
<b>TX, UT, VA, VT, WA, WI</b>	Searches in all counties are able to be completed as usual with minimal delays.
<b>WV</b>	Public access has been restored in all other WV counties. Please expect delays as the backlog is being worked through.(Significant delays expected in Braxton, Hampshire, Harrison, and Wood)
<b>WY</b>	All WY counties are very short staffed. Every county is clerk assisted. Please expect extended delays.
